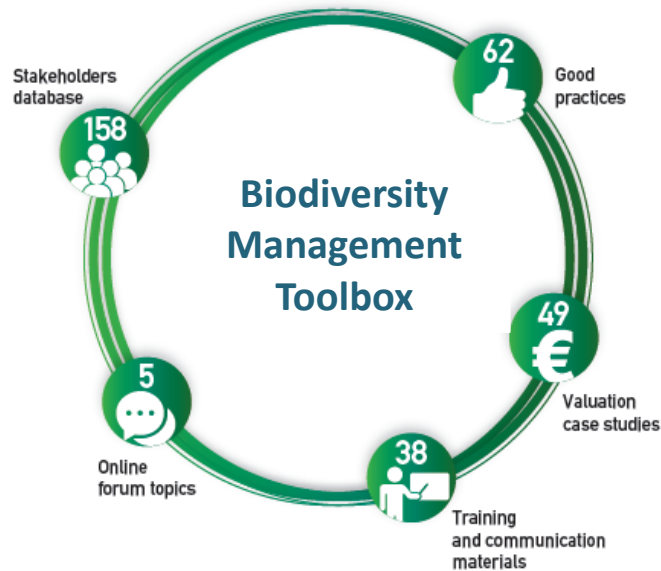

Searchable inventory of materials providing introductory background knowledge, developing capacities and sharing best practices for practical application targeting a variety of stakeholders and audiences.



### Online stakeholders communication forum

Available for registered stakeholders. It provides a way to discuss with peers, exchange information and search for partners for collaboration in biodiversity research activities.
